WHAT TO BRING

The accommodation is let to you on a self catering basis. We supply washing up liquid & anti-bacterial cleaning spray, toiletries, salt & pepper, a dish cloth, dis brush, spare bin liner & toilet rolls.

LINEN

Bed linen, towels, bath robes and a bath mat are provided.

ARRIVAL

Check in is from 3pm. If your accommodation is ready any earlier we will text you on the day. We operate a contact free check in- please let yourselves in to your property no earlier than 3pm (unless contacted beforehand) the hut will be left unlocked and the key will be left on the side.

DEPARTURE

Check out is 10am. Please put rubbish and recycling in the outside storage. Please empty the hot tub water by leaving open the blue handle lever valve (located at the bottom right of the hot tub) Please also empty the ash out of the hot tub stove into the ash bucket provided. Please leave the key on the side when you leave.

Please note that our cleaner works on an hourly basis, a late check-out fee of £20 per hour will be charged for late departures. We also ask that the hut is left reasonably clean and tidy; any excessive cleaning required or damages will incur an additional fee. Loss of keys will be a £30 charge.

THERE IS NO WIFI. Some networks provide 4G in the area.

KITCHENETTE

The kitchenette is equipped for preparing light meals only. It includes basic appliances such as a microwave, mini-fridge, kettle, mini oven, hob and toaster plus utensils suitable for simple food preparation, such as snacks or breakfast items and heating through meals. Due to space it is not suited for full cooking or heavy meal preparation and there is minimal food storage space. The mini fridge has a small freezer space for ice tray only (provided). When washing up please use the bowl and draining mat provided in the cupboard under the sink.

REFUSE & RECYCLING – Can be found in the outside storage.

Red bag – plastic & tins, Orange bag – cardboard, Black box – glass

DIRECTIONS

Approaching Newquay from the A30: At Indian Queens on the dual carriageway take the slip road on the left sign posted to Newquay. On the roundabout take the third exit on to the A39, continue for 1 mile. At the next roundabout take the third exit on to the A39 sign posted Wadebridge, continue for almost 2 miles. At the next roundabout- take the first exit on to the A3059 sign posted Newquay. After 2 miles take the turning on the right, signposted to Newquay airport and Mawgan Porth. You will pass the entrance to the Airport on your left, continue on this road and you will come to a T junction- take the right turning which leads to the B3276 coast road heading North. You will drive down to Mawgan Porth, over the narrow bridge, go past the beach and up the hill and you will come to a hairpin bend to the left with a turning on the right signposted St Eval, take this turning and 500 yards along this road on the you will see the sign for Merlin Farm. Continue SLOWLY down this private lane (keep to the left when lane splits into two). When you see a wooden sign in front of you saying 'Welcome to Merlin Farm' turn immediately left and then you'll see a sign in the left corner saying 'HIDDEN GLAMPING', the entrance is quite hidden. Wood Fired Hot Tub

The tub is filled with fresh water for your arrival.

As we do not use chemicals it is recommended you empty and refill the water every 3 days or so.

Please shower before using the tub and do not use any bubble bath etc.

You can also use the tub as a cold plunge pool.

Please only use the plastic drink ware provided if drinking when in the hot tub.

We supply some kindling, firelighter and logs to get you started, more can be purchased locally if required (kept in the outside storage).

Please keep the lid on the tub when not in use.

Step by step instructions

1. Plan ahead, this will stop you wasting wood, time and energy – as well as prevent the disaster of you being out for dinner when it's ready. It usually takes 1.5 to 3 hours (depending on the outside temp) to heat the water up to the correct temperature. Keeping the lid on will help the water heat up faster.

2. Clean out the burner if it's not already done, you can use a brush or small shovel for this and the ash bucket provided.

3. Select some kindling and arrange in a pyramid structure and pop a firelighter underneath. Make sure the vent on the door is open to give the fire oxygen. Once the kindling is burning well place some logs on top. Add small pieces of wood at a controlled pace, keeping a pyramid structure that allows air to the fire's centre (it needs oxygen to keep burning).

4. Keep checking the fire every 5-10 minutes, adding logs to keep the fire blazing.

5. During the heating process, take the top off the hot tub off and use the provided paddle to stir the water, as all hot water rises to the top. Once the water reaches your desired temperature (35°C - 37°C) it is ready to get in. Place a log on the fire so it heats up a little more while you enjoy the relaxing tub. You don't want the fire to die, but you also don't want the water to get too hot, so use your judgement to keep it warm.

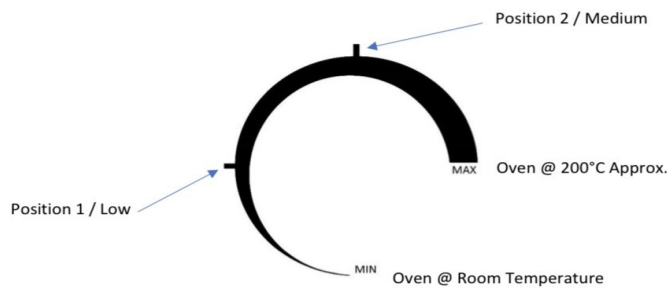
6. After use keep the lid on the hot tub as it will likely take less time to heat up if using the next day as well as keeping any debris out.

PLEASE ENSURE ALL OUTDOOR LIGHTS ARE SWITCHED OFF AFTER USE

EVERHOT MINI OVEN

The Everhot stove is a thermostatically controlled heater that gently warms the room and behind the cast iron door is a 20L oven perfect for cooking small dishes. It is intended primarily as a heat storage room heater with the option to use the oven space for occasional cooking. It is not intended to replace a cooker or range cooking appliance. Push the bottom left button in to turn on and turn the thermostat dial to turn the temperature up. The oven temperature is not directly controlled. The temperature is liable to drop if cold or room temperature food is put into the oven

and may take longer to recover the lost temperature than a cooker. Do not run the appliance with the door left open. Do not leave the appliance on overnight and when going out. Switch off using the bottom left bottom after use.



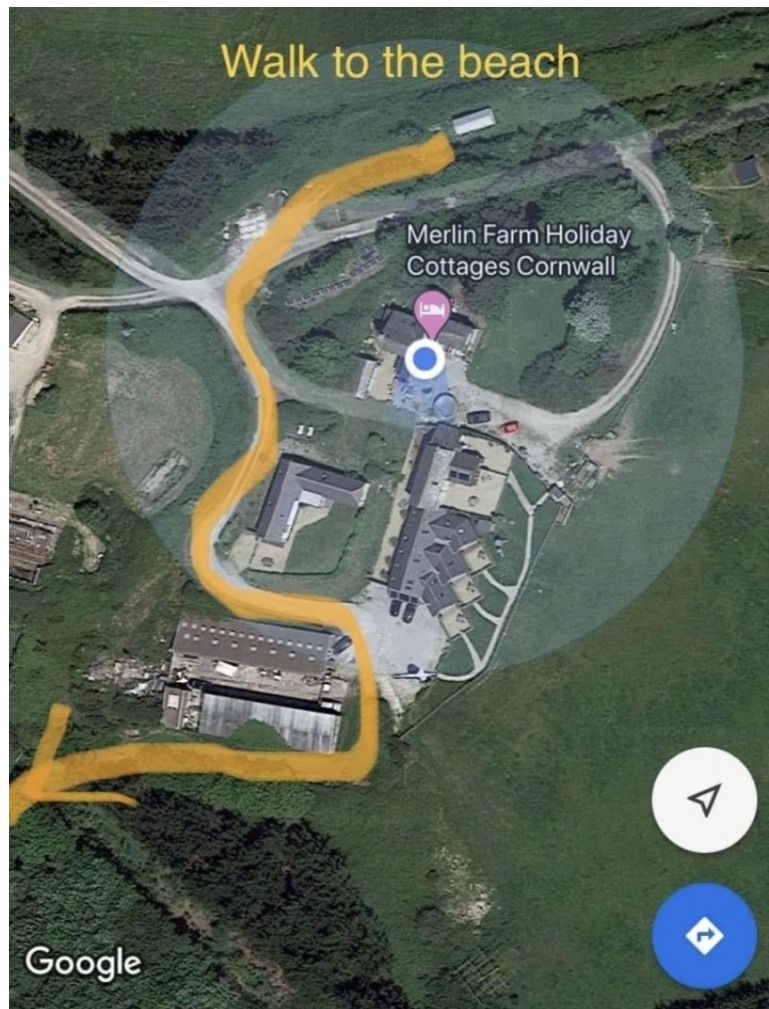
DRYING TOWELS

During the colder months the underfloor heating will be automatically set, you do not need to do anything. In the warmer months you may use the heater function on the Everhot. Please do not leave on when out and do not place anything on top covering the vent.
